### Scholarship Information

Iowa Western Community College Intercultural and International Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic achievement, involvement, and financial need.

#### Awards

- Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 (\$500 Fall/\$500 Spring) will be awarded to two continuing students who have completed at least 12 credit hours at Iowa Western (excluding ESL coursework) by May 30. This is a one year scholarship.
- Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 (\$500 Fall/\$500 Spring) will be awarded to two continuing Iowa Western students who have completed at least one semester of coursework in ESL or will complete ESL Level IV at the application deadline, which is March 15. This is a one year scholarship.
- Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 (\$500 Fall/\$500 Spring) will be awarded to two new students starting in either a degree program or ESL courses at Iowa Western. This is a one year scholarship.

#### Criteria

- Each student receiving the scholarship will be required to plan and facilitate 5 hours of cultural programming during the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded.

#### Eligibility

- Students must be a refugee, resident alien, or F-1 visa bearer, or otherwise born outside the U.S.
