*All scores expire after two years. In order to be valid, scores cannot be more than two years old at the start of the term. If you do not have valid test scores, you may call the testing center at the above number to schedule the COMPASS at no charge.
5. Take a Computer Programmers Aptitude Test (CPAT): Minimum tests scores are not required to enroll in any computer program. The score is used as an advising tool to determine which computer courses are taken in the first semester. To schedule the CPAT please call 800.432.5852, ext. 3277 or 712.325.3277.
